Carts near greens

The Course superintendent has asked the club to remind members that they should not drive carts within 5 metres of a green. This particularly applies at the 2nd and 14th green where players have been observed driving carts alongside of the green and in some cases on the green.

Check your Handicap

Recently a member was disqualified from winning a prize as the member had been red flagged on the Golf Australia handicap system. This means the player had 5 rounds in their last 20 where they had not submitted a card correctly and it has resulted in these rounds being flagged as NSNA (No Score – not Approved). This could be because they had pulled out of a round and not given their card to the Pro Shop so they could be classified as NSA (No Score – approved) or when they submitted their card they have not hit the “confirm score” button which will result in a NSNA flag. Please note this happens often and the club has no ability to correct this even if they become aware of it happening. Please ensure you do complete the process for submission of your score/card. If you do get red flagged please also note that if the oldest red flag is, say, your 18th latest round it will take two “correct” rounds before it drops off so please take care and ensure you complete the card submission process each time you play in a competition.
